**NOTICE OF PUBLIC
COMMENT PERIOD**

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 23-23 of the Rhode Island General Laws and Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 29, notice is hereby given that the Office of Air Resources is proposing to revise the Operating Permits for the following stationary sources:

FPLE Rhode Island State Energy, L.P.
24 Shun Pike
Johnston, RI 02919

Cranston Water Pollution Control Facility
140 Pettaconsett Ave
Cranston RI 02920

These two revisions are being processed as significant modifications in accordance with APC Regulation No. 29, Section 29.10.4.

FPLE Rhode Island State Energy's Major Source Permit (RI-PSD-6) was revised to include a facility-wide limit on natural gas consumption. Also, monitoring requirements for the cooling towers were revised. The operating permit has been revised to include these changes.


The Cranston Water Pollution Control Facility's NO_x RACT Agreement (95-11-AP) was revised to modify the monitoring and recordkeeping requirements. The operating permit has been revised to include these changes.

Only those conditions, which pertain to the proposed modifications, are being offered for public comment.

The public comment period for the significant modifications will begin today and continue until May 6, 2011. A public hearing for interested persons to appear and submit written or oral comments on the draft operating permit will be held if requested by 10 or more persons, or by a governmental subdivision or agency or by an association having not less than 10 members. Any interested person may request that a public hearing be held.

Written comments, to be considered part of the record must be submitted during the public comment period. Written comments or requests for a hearing maybe sent to the Office of Air Resources at the address below until 4:00 PM, 6 May 2011, at which time the public comment period will close.

The significant permit modification documentation and a document concerning public participation in the operating permit program are available for inspection at the Office of Air Resources, 235 Promenade Street, Providence RI from 8:30am to 4:00pm.
