**NOTICE OF FEE DETERMINATION**

Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 28 "Operating Permit Fees", Section 28.4.4 provides that beginning 1 September 1996, sources subject to the operating permit program must pay an annual emissions fee. Sources whose actual air pollution emissions are less than 10 tons per year pay a fixed fee. Fees for sources with actual emissions greater than or equal to 10 tons per year will be assessed on a per ton basis. The fee must generate at least enough revenue to cover the direct and indirect costs of running the Operating Permit Program.


The Office has made a preliminary determination that the fixed fee and dollar per ton fee to be used for the state fiscal year 2013 (1 July 2012 - 30 June 2013) are:

Fixed fee:	\$ 3,312.69
Dollar per ton fee:	\$ 331.27

The Office will determine the final fees by adjusting the preliminary fee determination to account for any monies that may be carried over from the previous fiscal year.
