**IN RE: Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 37**


The Director of the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (DEM) gives notice of the filing of Emergency Amendments to Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 37, "Rhode Island's Low-Emission Vehicle Program"

The purpose of this emergency regulation is to adopt the latest changes to the California Low Emission Vehicle (LEV) program, now called the Advanced Clean Car (ACC) program, into Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 37, "Rhode Island's Low-Emission Vehicle Program".
