**NOTICE OF PUBLIC  
COMMENT PERIOD**

The Office of Air Resources offers an opportunity for public comment regarding its proposal to issue Emissions Caps for the following stationary sources:

Narragansett Bay Commission, Field's Point WWTF, Providence, RI  
The Talaria Company LLC d.b.a The Hinckley Company, One Little Harbor Landing and  
1909 Alden Landing, Portsmouth, RI  
Veterans Administration Medical Center, 830 Chalkstone Avenue, Providence, RI

Narragansett Bay Commission will be issued an initial emissions cap to address emergency generators located at its Field's Point Waste Water Treatment Facility.

Emissions Cap No. 108-2013 for The Hinckley Company was issued on March 21, 2013. The emissions cap is being revised to address newly acquired processing equipment.

Emissions Cap No. 113-2013 for the Veterans Administration Medical Center was issued on June 31, 2013. The emissions cap is being revised to address a newly installed emergency generator.


Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 29 - Operating Permits contains provisions to allow sources to apply for an emissions cap. An emissions cap must be federally enforceable and include some combination of production and/or operational limitations to ensure that emissions are limited by quantifiable and enforceable means. An emissions cap relieves the stationary source from the requirement to obtain an operating permit.

The public comment period for the emissions caps will begin today and continue until 21 December 2015. A public hearing for interested persons to appear and submit written or oral comments on the draft emissions caps will be held if requested by 10 or more persons, or by a governmental subdivision or agency or by an association having not less than 10 members. Any interested person may request that a public hearing be held.

Written comments, to be considered part of the record must be submitted during the public comment period. Written comments or requests for a hearing may be sent to the Office of Air Resources at the address below until 4:00 PM, 21 December 2015, at which time the public comment period will close.

The draft emissions caps are available for inspection at the Office of Air Resources, 235 Promenade Street, Providence RI from 8:30am to 4:00pm. For more information, contact Richard Younkin or Ruth Gold at (401) 222-2808 (toll free 1-800-752-8088, TTY 711).
