**NOTICE OF PUBLIC
COMMENT PERIOD**

The Office of Air Resources offers an opportunity for public comment regarding its proposal to issue Emissions Caps for the following stationary sources:

Providence College, Huxley Avenue, Providence, RI
Roger Williams University, One Old Ferry Road, Bristol, RI

Emissions Cap No. 58-2009 for Providence College was issued on July 3, 2009. The emissions cap is being revised to address two newly installed boilers.

Emissions Cap No. 96-36 for Roger Williams University was issued on February 5, 1996 and terminated on August 2, 2000 with the removal of two large boilers. The emissions cap is being reissued to address newly installed emergency generators.

Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 29 - Operating Permits contains provisions to allow sources to apply for an emissions cap. An emissions cap must be federally enforceable and include some combination of production and/or operational limitations to ensure that emissions are limited by quantifiable and enforceable means. An emissions cap relieves the stationary source from the requirement to obtain an operating permit.

The public comment period for the emissions caps will begin today and continue until 8 April 2016. A public hearing for interested persons to appear and submit written or oral comments on the draft emissions caps will be held if requested by 10 or more persons, or by a governmental subdivision or agency or by an association having not less than 10 members. Any interested person may request that a public hearing be held.

Written comments, to be considered part of the record must be submitted during the public comment period. Written comments or requests for a hearing may be sent to the Office of Air Resources at the address below until 4:00 PM, 8 April 2016, at which time the public comment period will close.
