INSP 200 is an intensive course based on a nationally-sanctioned operation and maintenance service provider program, followed by an (optional) separately scheduled examination. Topics include inspecting and maintaining primary treatment and recirculation tanks, aeration components of different advanced treatment systems, pumps and dosing intervals, and safety issues. The course is designed to provide wastewater professionals interested in becoming service providers or inspectors with foundational knowledge and understanding applicable to a wide variety of technologies and their service requirements. Please note wastewater professionals are expected to complete additional training requirements for the proprietary technologies they plan to service.
