### Opportunities for Public Comment

The public comment period runs September 26, 2014

through Friday, October 31, 2014. Two public hearings will be held at the end of October, as follows:

- Tuesday, October 28th at 6:00pm at North Kingstown Senior Center, 44 Beach Street, North Kingstown Rhode Island

The hearings will begin with a one half hour informational presentation followed by opportunity for public comment. All persons may present their views on the draft document in person at the public hearings, through a representative, or by filing a written statement with the Secretary of the State Planning Council.

Written statements may be mailed to Melanie Jewett Army, AICP, Supervising Planner, RI Statewide Planning Program, One Capitol Hill, Providence, RI 02908, or submitted at a hearing. All comments must be received before 4:00 p.m. Friday, October 31, 2014.

### About the Economic Development Plan

The Economic Development Plan contains goals, policies, strategies, implementation actions, and performance measures for the State's Economic Development program over the next twenty years. The Rhode Island Department of Administration, Division of Planning's Statewide Planning Program, working in collaboration with the Rhode Island Commerce Corporation, is responsible for the development of this Plan. This Plan was also developed with public and private stakeholder participation, as well as state and federal agency collaboration.

The Economic Development Plan is one of the first products of an extensive outreach and research effort. Since August 2013, hundreds of Rhode Island citizens have participated and shared their ideas through 27 regional workshops, over 30 focus groups and meetings, as well as online, connecting with a wide array of groups and individuals, particularly reaching out to those who are traditionally under-represented in statewide planning initiatives

### COMPREHENSIVE HOUSING AFFORDABILITY STRATEGY (CHAS) DATA

The Rhode Island Statewide Planning Program, with assistance from Rhode Island Housing, has generated data tables for each municipality on housing needs by income level.

These data are pulled from a special tabulation of American Community Survey data provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development known as Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy, or CHAS, data.

The data tables, posted online at <http://www.planning.ri.gov/geodeminfo/data/chas.php>, will help municipalities understand housing needs in their communities and in the region.



On September 18, the U.S. Census Bureau released the 2013 1-Year American Community Survey (ACS) estimates. One-year ACS estimates are available for geographies with populations greater than 65,000, and describe the social, economic, and housing characteristics of people and places. These data can be downloaded from American FactFinder at <http://factfinder2.census.gov/> (to find the new data, select *Advanced Search*, and then *Topics > Dataset > 2013 ACS 1-year estimate*).

Also, on September 16, Income, Poverty and Health Insurance Coverage results for the nation were compiled from information collected in the 2014 Current Population Survey Annual Social and Economic Supplement and was released in two reports:

[\*Income and Poverty in the United States: 2013\*](#) and [\*Health Insurance Coverage in the United States: 2013\*](#).

The Current Population Survey Annual Social and Economic Supplement was conducted between February and April 2014 and collected information about income and health insurance coverage during the 2013 calendar year.

This is the annual release of national-level income, poverty and health insurance statistics from the Current Population Survey (CPS). The reports include statistics for calendar year 2013 and compare trends from previous years. The health insurance report includes a few tables showing trends and state-level health insurance coverage between 2008 and 2013 from the American Community Survey.

On October 23, The Census Bureau will be releasing the **2011-2013 American Community Survey 3-Year Estimates**. The statistics derived from three years of data collection cover all geographic areas with populations of 20,000 or more. Comparison profiles showing statistically significant changes compare two non-overlapping three-year periods (2008-2010 and 2011-2013).
