




## **Fisheries Notification**

National Grid, Deepwater Wind and its Contractors LS Cable and Kokosing-Durocher Marine Division are planning to conduct supplemental marine surveys along select locations of the **Block Island Transmission System and the Block Island Wind Farm** 

submarine cable routes.



- •Utilize the F/V Heather Lynn docked out of Galilee, RI
- •Conduct supplemental geotechnical investigations to confirm ocean bottom conditions along approved cable routes
- •Vessel to be equipped with jet probe to target approximately 19 verification points
- •Additional test probes may be advanced depending on subsurface conditions encountered
- •Investigations to avoid and not dislodge fishing gear/tackle
- •USCG Local Notice of Mariners to be provided
- •Estimated start date of June 8, 2015
- •7-14 days at sea to complete marine surveys
