Lobster Trap Transfer Program Interested Parties

Lobster Trap Transfer Application Workshop Announcement Meeting Dates: Wednesdays, August 26, 2015 and September 2, 2015

Earlier this year, we announced a new Lobster Trap Transfer Program for Federal lobster permit holders. The program allows permit holders the flexibility to buy and sell trap allocation for Lobster Conservation Management Areas 2, 3, and the Outer Cape. Trap transfer applications are due by September 30, 2015, and will be effective May 1, 2016.

To encourage participation in the program and to reduce confusion, we are hosting two public workshops for all interested parties to learn the process of submitting a trap transfer application. Workshops will cover background information on the trap transfer program, its function, and the application process. Then we will provide specific examples of potential transfer scenarios before opening the floor for questions.
