RI Summer Flounder Aggregate Landing Program 2018 Winter sub-period Application Form and Instructions

This application is to obtain a permit to land up to 1,500 pounds of Summer Flounder per vessel per biweekly period during the Winter sub-period as specified in the RI Marine Fisheries regulations (RIMFR) "Part 3 - Finfish". Cumulative landings must occur within the bi-weekly periods are specified below.

Issuance of the permit may take several days upon receipt of a completed application. It is the responsibility of the applicant to assure the timely and accurate submittal of the application to avoid delays in receiving their permit.

The 2018 Winter sub-period begins on February 4 and ends on April 30, or when 90% of the Winter sub-period quota has been harvested as determined by DFW.

The starting possession limit is 1,500 pounds/vessel/bi-week. Possession limits are subject to change throughout the sub-period. It is the responsibility of the permittee to follow all regulations to maintain compliance with their permit.

An applicant who is permitted for the Winter sub-period is not eligible to participate in the Summer subperiod of the same year.

Criteria for eligibility:

- 1. The owner must possess a RI Summer Flounder Exemption Certificate.
- 2. The owner and operator(s) must hold a valid 2018 commercial license capable of landing summer flounder (i.e., MPURP, PEL, RESLND, NRLNDR).
- 3. The vessel shall be operated by a licensed person who has not been assessed a criminal or administrative penalty in the past three years for a violation of RIMFR Part 3 Finfish, or more than one marine fisheries violation.

February 4 through February 17 February 18 through March 3 March 4 through March 17 March 18 through March 31 April 1 through April 14 April 15 through April 28 April 29 – April 30
