The Rhode Island Pretreatment Regulations (250-RICR-150-10-2) adopt and incorporate the General Pretreatment Regulations at 40 C.F.R. Part 403 promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on January 28, 1981. These Regulations, mandated by the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq., govern the control of industrial waste introduced into municipal sewage treatment plants.

Pursuant to the Rhode Island Pretreatment Regulations, the applicant has submitted a request for an approval of a modification to its Industrial Pretreatment Program. The proposed modification consists of a revision to Quonset Business Park Devolvement Regulation 880-RICR-00-00-4, which acts as the Sewer Use Ordinance for the QDC wastewater treatment facility. The amendments to 880-RICR-00-00-4.16 are intended to standardize terminology and to clarify who must apply for wastewater permits and the process by which permits are reviewed and approved. The amendments include clarifications to the definitions of industrial user and significant noncompliance. Additionally, language has been added to assert certain authorities that are provided by 250-RICR-150-10-2 and 40 CFR 403. The request for approval consists of an endorsement statement from the QDC Board of Directors, including a public notice that QDC conducted from April 23, 2025, to May 23, 2025. This public notice serves as DEM's requirement to issue a public notice soliciting public comment in accordance with 250-RICR-150-10-2 and 40 CFR 403.11(b).

Please note that if no comments to this notice are received, the proposed modification will be approved without changes and without further public notice. In such event, this public notice shall constitute the "notice of approval or disapproval" required by 403.11(e).

All persons who believe any condition of the proposed modification is inappropriate, must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and submit all reasonably available arguments and factual grounds supporting their position, including all supporting material, by the close of the public comment period. Commenters may request a longer comment period if necessary to provide a reasonable opportunity to comply with these requirements. Comments should be directed to Madison Heller as indicated above.
