Statement of Duties: Ensures that all mechanical and electrical equipment at the wastewater treatment plant and sewage pumping stations is functional and properly maintained. Performs all necessary repairs and preventative maintenance on all equipment and structures associated with the treatment plants and pumping stations including all collection system maintenance activities. Duties include:

- Completes all work orders pertaining to preventative maintenance.
- Performs more complex troubleshooting and repair work that is above the ability of a Mechanic I.
- Inspects, examines and tests all equipment to ensure it is functioning properly and that all back-up systems are ready to be put on-line as needed.
- Documents and reports to the supervisor any equipment that requires additional attention or possible replacement.
- Guides, instructs and trains Mechanic I positions as necessary.
- Lubricates motors and equipment and checks other equipment
- Replaces bearings in motors, pumps and other equipment.
- Adjusts and cleans wastewater equipment.
- Installs and sets up new equipment.
- Operates Sewer Authority trucks and participates in snow plowing operations.
- Checks boilers and generators at pump stations and plan.
- Performs all duties of an Operator as needed.
- Performs related work as required.

Education & Experience: Graduation from a standard high school or vocational school, including or supplemented by courses of mechanical or electrical nature. Experience sufficient to ensure proficiency in the repair of gasoline and diesel engines, electrical motors, and in the welding of metal parts for various kinds of machinery; or any equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Requirement: Applicants must possess and maintain a State of RI Class I Sewer System Operator Certificate of Competency or obtain such certificate **within one (1) year of the date of employment, or be terminated.** Must also possess and maintain as valid state issued driver's license. A driver's license check will be performed.

Negative findings may prevent applicants from being considered.
